♥ Two times of struggle for living



Witnessing the four-year-old little child suffering from heart disease, the poor parents could not keep back their tears. With the low wages from hired works plus household expenses in daily life, they were not able to manage a sum large of money for the baby's heart operation. That is a story of Mr. Bao and Mrs. Thanh, whose son named Le Gia Khoa with heart defect, live in Phu Cat Ward, Hue City.



Getting married since 2004, Mr. Bao and Mrs. Thanh have got 3 children. The first-born child is 9 years old, the second child is 5 years old and the third child – Le Gia Khoa is 4 years old. The whole family is living in a small house in a deep alley of To Hien Thanh Street. The house has been old and downgraded. That is all property that Mr. Bao's parents have left.



Visiting Mr. Bao's family in a rainy day, we were moved when the little house has a lot of leaks, there was even no dry place to sit together. It always lack of light because there are a lot of surrounding high-rise building. In there, we heard a sad story about their life. After the marriage, Mrs. Thanh continued selling vegetable in Vy Da market which is her previous work. At that time, Mr. Bao was unemployed. He was always ready to do anything if hired. Their life elapsed like that. Their children were born in turn. Although their background family was very

difficult, they were always happy with small family. Then Mr. Bao also found a job more stable which was that motorcycle – keeper at Hue Junior College of Education. His earning was enough to buy milk for children. Mrs. Thanh herself hucksters all year around and took care of family meal every day.

When Le Gia Khoa was 5 months old, he had a high fever, so his parents just thought that Khoa got virus fever. As a result, Khoa was sent to local medical station for a medical examination. The doctors suggested that Khoa needed treating at Hue central hospital for careful treatment. They were getting worry because they didn't know how Khoa's condition was that he was transferred in Hue central hospital. Until they were reported about Khoa's heart disease, his parents were numbed.

Khoa was requested to treat with medicines. Looking their beloved child like an angel but having trouble breathing, his mother wished that she could replace Khoa to stand the heart defect. Since that time, his parents took Khoa to Hue central hospital for medical examination and buying medicines every month. However, when Khoa was 3 years old, Khoa's condition did not only ease up but also worsened. He needed an urgent operation with the operation fee of 35 million VND. Since they knew the operation fee, they had been so worried and did not know how to manage it. With the monthly income of 2.5 million VND and unstable job, it was not



enough to cover subsistence expenses, let alone Khoa's surgery fee.

On September 2012, Khoa's condition was introduced to OGCDC. Thanks to the concern and kindness of sponsors, Khoa was supported with operation fee in full not long after. They thought that they no longer worried about Khoa's health anymore. However, just 10 months after the operation, Khoa fainted when he was playing with his brother. One more time, Khoa was sent to the hospital. They seemed to fall into abyss there when Khoa must be operated again with the operation fee of 55 million VND according to the doctors. Holding the operation fee note on their hands, Mr and Mrs Bao just could cry. They had to take Khoa return home because they did not have financial ability to manage such a sum large of money.

Leaving the hospital for a week but Khoa was fainted away for many times. They used to witness Khoa stand in front of the boundary between life and death. This time made Mrs Thanh stand steady. There was no more way, so they just took him to Hue central hospital for provisional treatment. Although they really wanted to earn more money for Khoa's surgery but there was nothing valuable in their family to sale or pledge. They also could not borrow everywhere.

Finally, they came to OGCDC and expected miracle come to them one more time. As last time, Khoa is lucky to receive the support from generous sponsors of office. Khoa's operation was conducted quickly and successfully. After a month of hospitalization, Khoa returned home with a healthy heart and a better life.

On July 2013, 36 patients with cleft lip and palate were operated in the Hospital of Hue University of



Medicine and Pharmacy in the cooperation program of Chonbuk National University (Korea) and Faculty of Odontology, Hue University of Medicine and Pharmacy. At this program, AFEPS Association (France) has supported a part of operation fees for patients (1,000,000 vnd per patient) and fees for speech therapy for parents of children with cleft lip and palate

after operation.

LOAN PROGRAM

WITHDRAWAL OF LOAN PROGRAM IN PHU VANG DISTRICT, THUA THIEN HUE PROVINCE

From July to September of 2013, OGCDC conducted the withdrawal of loan from the families with disabled children in Phu Vang district, Thua Thien Hue province. On this time, we conducted turning over loan of 27 families among 40 families in loan program in Phu Vang district. This program brought more advantages for the families to develop the economic situation. However, with many objective factors such as epidemic which made more cattle and domestic fowls died, the children usually have been sick so that some families are still more difficult, so they still could not pay back the loan.

GRANTING SCHOLARSHIP FOR UNDERPRIVILEGED PUPILS AND COLLEGE STUDENTS AFTER CARDIAC SURGERY

OPENING CEREMONY OF SCHOOL YEAR 2013-2014

There are participating of leader committee, teachers, students and parents. Beside the aim of educating student with intellectual disabilities, in this school year, the school will promote the vocational training for students up to 16 year old as the need of students as well as their parent's aspiration.

Because of weather condition, the students of Future school cannot attend the "Mid-Autumn Festival" which is organized every year by the Youth Centre. However, with the support of Blue Blouse group, a volunteer group of Hue University of Medicine and Pharmacy, all children have chance to enjoy in a very funny party with Mid Autumn gifts.

OPENING CEREMONY OF DUC SON CLASS IN SCHOOL YEAR OF 2013-2014

In August 9, 2013, all students of two special classes in Nam Dong have started the new school year after long time of summer holiday. In this school year, we have received 1 more new children and the total of 2 classes is 16 children now. Most of students in Duc Son class have the mobility disabilities, every week, the therapist come to class and give the therapy for children. The incense making class is running well and all the products are bought by the visitors.

03 SPECIAL CLASSES IN NAM DONG START NEW SCHOOL YEAR



03 special classes in Nam Dong mountainous district has start new school year. Because of bad weather condition, the children did not go to class regularly. The teachers, therefore, have to come every house and encourage the children. The classes are working under control of the local supervisor in Nam Dong and OG CDC staff.

PHYSICAL THERAPY AND REHABILITATION PROGRAM

After 2 month of summer holiday, schools and centers, which are directly under OG CDC, started get back operation. Physiotherapies continue to go to those schools and centers to support teachers to do physical therapy for children with motor disability.



In the last September, physical therapy group cooperated to Early Intervention Program to training for parents with motor disability at Huong Tra and Huong Thuy



commune. The training aims to increase the knowledge of parents about motor disability, barriers to participation in daily activities and the importance of physical therapy. In addition, physical therapist also does home visiting to assess movement ability of children and guide the parents suitable exercise for their children. This is the first program to support to children with disability and their parents in Huong Thuy and Huong Tra commune. Therefore, all the parents are very interested and enthusiastic to participate in the program.

EARLY EDUCATION PROGRAM

MEDICAL EXAMINATION AND GENERAL ASSESSMENT FOR SCREENING UNDER-SIX CHILDREN WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DELAY IN HUONG THUY AND HUONG TRA DISTRICTS

In the program “Early identification and Early intervention for under-six children with developmental delay in Huong Thuy and Huong Tra districts” under the support of Schmitz Stiftung (Germany), GIZ organization (Germany) and Handicap International (Belgium), during 2 days of 08 & 09 of August, 2013, the OGCDC organized pediatric medical examination and child’s ability assessment for screening 100 under-six children in the two areas who are detected as developmental delay by the local health and social workers. After the screening, parents with delay child have been advised to participate in the family-based early intervention program.



TRAINING COURSES FOR LOCAL HEALTH AND SOCIAL WORKERS ON EARLY IDENTIFICATION AND EARLY INTERVENTION FOR UNDER-SIX CHILDREN WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DELAY.

With the aim of promoting early identification and early intervention for under-six children with developmental delay, under the support of Schmitz Stiftung (Germany), GIZ organization (Germany) and Handicap International (Belgium) in the project “*Early identification and Early intervention for under-six children with developmental delay in Huong Thuy and Huong Tra districts*”, at first, we have conducted training courses for local health and social workers in these two districts by the end of July. With the provided knowledge and materials, the local staff can start recognizing children with some signs of developmental delay and organizing communal meetings for awareness rising in the community about disability issues. Hopefully, the program can bring new steps for young children with developmental delay and their families, and by the way it is remarkable point that helps the community understand better disability issues.



TRAINING AND TECHNICAL SUPPORT FOR PARENTS WITH DISABLED CHILDREN.

Following up medical examination and screening for under-six children with developmental delay, by the mid of August, a 24-day training course was organized for the parents of 30 eligible children in Huong Thuy and Huong Tra towns. The parents also received practical professional support of supervisors from OGCDC in guiding parents’ performance on their children at home using home-made materials as trained. The aims of activity are to improve capacity for the parents in giving supportive methods for their children and also to enhance their roles and responsibility in giving support for their children. These help solve problems of inadequate personnel of giving technical support for disabled children in the two areas. After the training courses, some parents will be selected as local advisors who will give support for the further families in their community.



EQUIPMENT OF MATERIAL CUPBOARD FOR HEALTH CENTERS IN HUONG THUY AND HUONG TRA



In the scope of the family-based early intervention under the support of Schmitz Stiftung organization (GIZ - Germany) and Handicapped International (Belgium), with the aim of enhancing awareness raising for community and supporting people with disabilities, by the end of September, we handed over 2 materials cupboards for the two health centers in Huong Thuy and Huong Tra towns. We hope that these resources will provide more opportunities for local health/social staff as well as local people get access to the service and have thing in action for people with disabilities.

ENHANCING CAPACITY FOR TEACHERS AND THERAPISTS IN EARLY INTERVENTION PROGRAM

Case conference and training courses are two of key activities that help improve capacities for the early intervention team. These activities are still on-going in the last quarter with participation of teachers and therapists under the professional support of German expert (GIZ organization) and OGCDC staff. Most of surveyed problems are teachers' challenge of working with autistic children. With the advanced trainings, our teachers as well as the therapists are more skillful in supporting these children and their parents.



THE EARLY INTERVENTION CLASSES IN HUE AND NAM DONG STARTED NEW SCHOOL YEAR 2013-2014



In the rhythm of starting school year, by the beginning of August, the early intervention class in Hue and Nam Dong were ready for welcoming the new school year 2013-2014. In the school year, one child in Hue class started joining in normal kindergarten as inclusive education and he will be kept updated on the progress by OGCDC as well as for further support. Meanwhile, another new child with autistic signs was admitted to attend at the class for early intervention. We hope that with the set-up curriculum for the class,

the children can get access to therapeutically and educational service in order to partly gain independence.

THE VISITING AND WORKING OF TWO MEMBERS FROM COR ENTERPRISES (USA)



From 05th to 12th August 2013, we were very happy to welcome Mr. Tony Anthony Francis Cline and Ms. Leigh Ann from COR Enterprises (USA) to visit and work at Office of Genetic Counseling and Disabled Children (OGCDC). By this visit, Mr. Tony and Ms. Leigh Ann visited some activities for people with disabilities in the system of OGCDC and spent the time with the artisans at Healing The

Wounded Heart Shop. Moreover, Mr. Tony and Ms. Leigh Ann visited Blind School and Vocational training and Job Promotion Center for handicapped and orphans.
